### 1. Discussion Topics

- Review/discussion: Response to DNR letter: Recording monument replacement  
Ms. Lagerberg stated that the letter did a good job answering the questions posed by DNR and the Survey Advisory Board (SAB), however, she cautioned the response should not be crafted to be a legal opinion, and it should reflect only the opinion of the board.

Mr. Galli provided some background on the questions asked. He stated that DNR has a permitting process, where they provide a form, but historically it didn't track whether a monument was replaced. When the form was revised to ask for record of survey information, the Survey Advisory Board received questions about the authority to require a survey.

Ms. Lagerberg said she would rather the Assistant Attorney General assigned to the DNR/Survey Advisory Board get involved with answering the questions posed by the SAB. However, she, Mr. Wengler and Mr. Blaisdell will work together to edit the letter to answer the questions as they relate to PLS practice, and not provide comment on the DNR permitting processes.

- Determine the pathways to state specific PLS exam (on-going)
- Work with DNR on the Survey Recording Act and Associated WACs to determine our regulatory direction for "intelligent interpretation" and other items (on-going)


