Discussion topics:

Decoupling exams

The committee discussed the decoupling of the PE and PLS exams only, SE decoupling discussion will be returned to the Structural Committee for discussion and consideration.

Recommendation to the board to move forward with decoupling the PE and PLS exams.

PE by comity app review = approved

The committee reviewed an application for PE by comity. The applicant is a professor who also possesses practical work experience from the early stages of his career. However, the applicant faced challenges in obtaining verifiers from that early period, as they were no longer available. To address this issue, the applicant provided a detailed written timeline outlining the early portion of his career for the committee's consideration and review.

• PE by initial app review =

The committee met on 10/9/24 to review, but additional review time was requested for review, committee met on 10/16/24 in Spokane WA at Gonzaga University in the La Storta room. The committee reviewed the foreign experience application for consideration for PE by initial license. The applicant took and passed the FE in Oregon and their PE via JPEC (NCEES Japan). The experience provided seems to be more project management and construction management. Staff will be requesting the applicant to submit additional information showing engineering specifics and offering a phone call with Director Fuller and committee member Mike Harney to discuss what should be on the experience form for review.

PLS state exam results

Cut score: 28/40

There was a total of 38 examinees, 20 passed giving a pass rate of 54%

OS state exam results

Cut score: 82/100

There was a total of 19 examinees, 6 passed, and out of those 6, 4 were

designers and 2 inspectors. The pass rate was 31%
