• PLS and On-Site Exam cut scores

Ms. Horton presented the cut score for the new PLS exam and Mr. Fuller presented the On-Site cut score, both exams administered in March 2025.

<u>PLS</u> – cut score 28/40 36 examinees 28 passing Pass rate: 78% <u>OS</u> - cut score 81/99 - one incorrect question removed. 21 examinees 12 passing Pass rate: 57%

- Decoupling Progress RCW 18.43 rewrite Ms. Lagerberg explained the changes to RCW 18.43 that support decoupling.

Ms. Jackson inquired if the board can better define what an EIT is and the process of receiving an EIT certificate.

Ms. Jackson mentioned that an applicant does not need to receive an EIT certificate before they apply and receive a Professional Engineer license.
